Design and make your own labyrinth. You could do it on paper (2D), or make it out of string, straws, card or wood (3D)	Learn a poem to recite to the class that has a Greek theme or is based on a Greek Fable or Myth.	Design and make a Spartan helmet.	Find out about the Greek Alphabet and create an interesting way to present your findings.	Write an advert persuading people to visit the ancient Olympic Games. What events took place? Where did participants come from?	Research a Greek figure and create a fact file or biography about them. For example, who was Pythagoras?
Find out about Greek food and create a meal. Write up the recipe and explain to the class what it tasted like. Could you take a picture and send it to the office for us to share?	Design a Greek vase. Ensure your design is symmetrical. You might want to use a mirror to help.	Make a collage using pictures from holiday brochures or the internet showing ancient buildings and interesting places to visit in Greece.	Research one of the Greek Gods and create a piece of art about them. Include facts and eye-catching information. Do they have a special symbol?	Create a piece of work explaining what life was like in Ancient Greece for children.	Find out some simple Greek words and phrases, for example: hello, how are you? What is your name? My name is... Please, thank you. Learn the pronunciation and can you teach us at school?
