

## Personal, Social and Health Education

Using the Jigsaw PSHE Scheme, we will be

- thinking about how we can all make our school a safe and happy place in which everyone can learn
- understanding the school's expectations for behaviour and learning
- contributing our ideas and listening to each other to make a class charter
- learning about making choices and consequences

## Maths

As Mathematicians we will be:

- developing our knowledge and understanding of place value to 10
- practising counting forwards and backwards to 100
- learning to form numbers to 10 correctly
- developing our addition and subtraction skills, using a mastery approach
- exploring concrete, pictorial and abstract methods to represent numbers

## Music

Through the song "My Musical Heart" we will be learning:

- to listen to music with concentration and understanding.
- to find and march in time to the pulse of main.
- to clap rhythms and know that the rhythm is different to the pulse.
- to play instrumental parts accurately and in time.

## Art

In Art this term we will be learning to:

- create different types of lines.
- explore line and mark making to draw water.
- draw with different media
- apply an understanding of drawing materials and mark making to draw from observation.

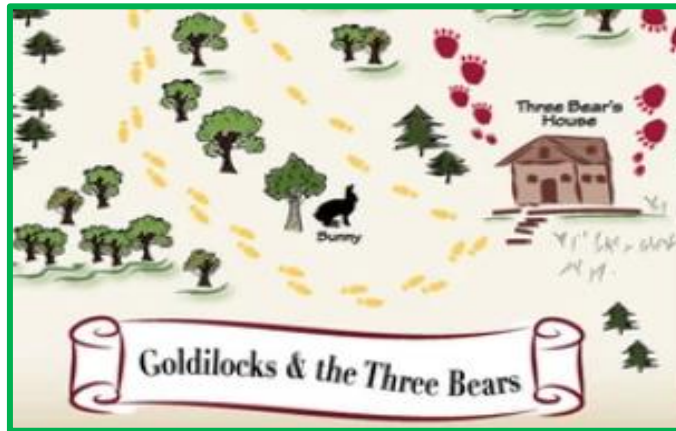
## Sport and PE

Year 1 will be taught PE on a **Wednesday** and a **Friday**

Our **Real PE** sessions, we will help us develop our co-ordination, balance and agility.

During our **Real Gym** sessions, we will be learning:

- to make different shapes with our bodies.
- about different ways of traveling across a space.
- about flight and rotation and how we can do this safely.

## Literacy

Our focus in Literacy this half term is 'Stories in familiar settings'. We will be:

- listening to and learning stories (talk for writing)
- asking and answering questions about the stories, main events and characters
- writing simple sentences to tell a narrative.
- using full stop at the end of a sentence and begin to use capital letter at start of sentence.
- beginning to use the grammar vocabulary 'adjective'
- leaving finger spaces in between words and forming lower case letters correctly.
- using phonics and Red words words in reading and writing.

## Science

As Scientists we will be learning to:

- naming the five senses.
- identify which part of the body is used for each sense.
- name parts of the human body.
- identify parts of the human body.
- to ask simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways
- use simple equipment to perform tests.

## Computing

This half term we will be learning:

- how to switch on computers and login safely.
- the importance of logging out.
- how to keep safe online.
- about technology in the world around us.

## RE

Our Big Question this half term is "Why do most Christians call God "Creator"?" We will be:

- exploring the biblical story of creation
- learning about God's character through creation and God's purpose for his creation
- exploring God's view of creation in the Psalms e.g. Psalm 8 focusing on the beauty and purpose of God's creation including the beauty of the physical world and the role of mankind looking after it.

## Geography

In Geography we will be learning to:

- recognise a plan, a map and symbols used
- to identify man made and natural features
- use locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map.
- Interpret aerial photographs.
- use a floor plan of our school to navigate.
