



<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Addition Subtraction Shapes</p> <p>We will continue to develop our addition and subtraction skills, using a mastery approach and exploring concrete, pictorial and abstract methods to represent numbers.</p> <p>We will learn to recognise and sort 2D and 3D shapes. We will identify faces, edges and vertices and also recognise lines of symmetry.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Recount writing - Writing based upon real events and personal perspective.</p> <p>Letter writing - Writing a letter to persuade Pip the owl that the dark is ok.</p> <p>Letter writing - Writing formal letters to Bracknell mayor persuading them to take action over habitat destruction.</p>	<p><u>Phonics/Spellings/Reading</u></p> <p>Daily Spelling with Jungle Club lessons help us to become increasingly confident with applying our phonic knowledge to our writing, looking at the different ways of spelling a sound in different words.</p> <p>Daily whole class reading lessons help us to practise and develop our reading skills, including fluency and expression as a reader.</p>	<p><u>Personal Development</u></p> <p>Economic wellbeing We will learn about money - where it comes from, the value of different notes and coins, how some sources of money are better than others. We will consider the difference between wants and needs and why some people may need to prioritise needs over wants. We will learn about saving money and how this can help us to have the things that we want as well as the things that we need.</p>	<p><u>Religious Education</u></p> <p>Judaism is our focus religion this half term. We will be considering the ways in which the Synagogue is important to Jewish people.</p> <p>As we approach Christmas, we will also remind ourselves of the Nativity Story and consider why Christmas is important to Christians.</p>

They use this knowledge to design a new chair for a bear.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>We will learn about playing in an orchestra. In addition to our music lessons, we will be learning and rehearsing lots of songs for our Nativity performance.</p>
