

Home Learning – Year 3

Daily Reading	Spelling	Maths
- Please read every day with your child, taking time to talk about the story, discuss the pictures and ask questions. Reading folders must come in to school every day. - Books will be changed at regular intervals after the book must be read more than once before being changed. - Where possible please also read to your child. Please comment in your child's reading record at least once a week.	- Your child will be given a list of spellings to learn each term on a weekly basis. - These may sometimes be a recap on your child's previous learning. Please help your child to learn their spellings and practise them regularly. - Children need to be able to spell the words correctly in the context of a dictated sentence. Spellings are practised and checked online using Spelling Shed – if you need your child's logon details, please ask.	- All number bonds to 10, 20, 50, 100, 1,000 e.g.: $6+4=10$, $60+40=100$, $600+400=1,000$ - Then moving on to finding 1, 10, 100, 1000 more and less than these numbers. - Continue to practise partitioning numbers into hundreds, tens and ones. - Practise the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). - Regular times table practice is essential. Please concentrate on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables this year, with revision of 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Please use Numbots and TTRS online at home to practise maths. If you need your child's logon details, please ask.
