

Cross Curricular Maths Length and height Mass, capacity and temperature Fractions We will learn about measuring in cm/m and compare/order lengths and heights. We will also learn about mass, volume and capacity, measuring in grams, kilograms, litres, millilitres. We will learn about fractions by first recognising equal and unequal parts. We will learn to recognise halves, thirds and quarters.	Cross Curricular English Fiction - Narrative: Writing to entertain with seaside adventure stories linked to Traction Man. Fiction - Postcards: Writing to inform and entertain with postcards about the seaside. Information – Save our seaside: Writing to persuade and inform on plastic pollution in the sea.	Phonics/Spellings/Reading Daily Spelling with Jungle Club lessons help us to become increasingly confident with applying our phonic knowledge to our writing, looking at the different ways of spelling a sound in different words. Daily whole class reading lessons help us to practise and develop our reading skills, including fluency and expression as a reader.	Personal Development We will be learning about our physical and emotion health and wellbeing. We will be learning to recognise and express our emotions and talk about our strengths and challenges, considering growth mindset. We will explore breathing exercises as a relaxation tool. We will learn about basic hygiene such as brushing our teeth. We will learn the importance of a healthy diet.	Religious Education Christianity – We will be considering the big question: ‘How do Christians decide what is right?’ We will consider the ten commandments, the story of Zacchaeus and also think about what it means to have a conscience.
Science We will learn about: Plants – Bulbs and Seeds - the difference, conditions for growth, making practical observations. Wildlife - What does wildlife do for us? What can we do for wildlife?
