Maths

As Mathematicians we will be:

- developing our understanding of place value in numbers to 50
- Counting in tens, fives and twos.
- Using mathematical language to describe length, height, weight and capacity/volume.
- Measuring with non-standard units and comparing measures.

English

In English we will be:

- writing questions to find out information about people (using capital letter and question mark)
- using our questions to interview people and making notes
- writing a simple biography
- practising oracy skills to perform our Year group assembly

Sport and PE

PE will be taught on a **Tuesday** and Year 2 will swim on **FRIDAYS**

In indoor PE we will be:

- Learning to control our body movements.
- Developing our Gymnastic skills.

In outdoor PE we will be:

- Focusing on Locomotion.
- Exploring different ways of moving.

RE

In RE we will be:

- thinking about “Why do symbols and stories play important roles in religions?” and listening to stories from the Hindu faith (eg The story of Holi)
- learning about Lent and Easter, including Shrove Tuesday and Mothering Sunday and 40

Music

In Music, we are going to explore the interrelated dimensions of music through:

- Warm-up games and singing a song
- Playing instruments with the song
- Improvising and composing.

Art and DT

In the context of dips and dippers:

- Explore existing products and give evaluations that contain some detail.
- Explain the food groups and know they have to eat a balance of foods to have a healthy and varied diet.
- Design & make a new product that is appealing to themselves and others.

Science

As Scientists, we will be learning about the human body

- We will be labelling the different parts of the body
- Identifying their functions.
- Investigating the 5 senses (touch, smell, sight, hearing and taste)and linking to the body parts
- Learning how to keep your body healthy

Computing

In Computing, we will:

- Experiment with tools on publisher
- Using the different tools children will create a poster to keep the school area clean and tidy
- Save and re-open.

Personal, Social and Health Education

In PSHE we will be:

- learning the importance of hygiene, in particular, when and how to wash hands
- linked to our DT topic this term, explaining the food groups and know that a balance of foods is needed for a healthy and varied diet.

History/Geography

- Identify where the Crimea is using maps and Google Earth.
- Discuss the weather and climate in the Crimea
- Explore the lives and work of Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell.
