

### **Literacy**

We will also look at:

SPAG work to ensure improved spelling (using No Nonsense Spelling and CHIMPing!), punctuation and grammar skills

### **Maths**

Measures – including converting them.

On-going revision of previous topics.

### **Science**

Habitats using the Empiribox scheme.

This will also lead on to which creatures live where and food chains with a plethora of great experiments and activities to learn from.

### **ICT**

Using the suite is still tricky with sharing facilities etc but we will try to research to support our Geography topic and, if possible, make information films about it too.

### **PSHE – Healthy Me**

Using our Jigsaw scheme to look at all aspects of keeping healthy – subjects like medicines, alcohol and tobacco will be parts of the discussions too. I will look at the mental health / Wellbeing aspects too to try to support the children in these testing times.

## **Trade and Economics**

### **PE/Games –**
